ORDERS FOR THE EXECUTION OF ALLIED PEW.

Scmetime between 3 FEE 42 and the morning of 6 FEB 42 orders were given by Rear Admiral HATAKEYAMA as Commander 24 Naval Base Special Force to Capt HATAKEYAMA as Commander of the Combined Forces who in turn passed them on to Lt NAKAGAWA the Officer Commanding 1st Kure Landing Party for the execution of all Allied PsW in the Japanese hands on the HITOB Peninsular.
